## July Program Update

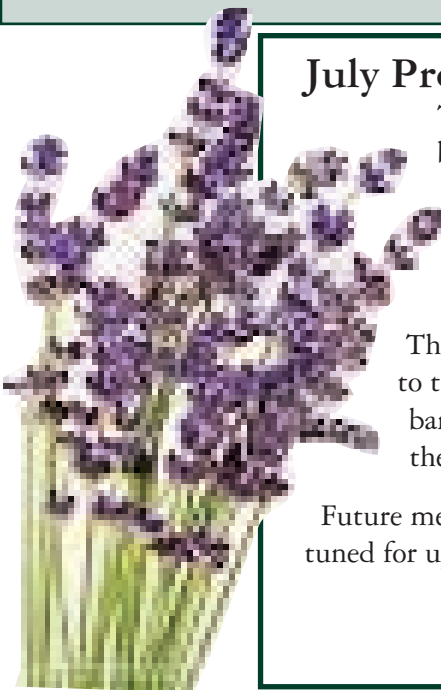
